ViBe is a new company made of three partners brought together by the talent of their children in the field of gymnastics, each member met at Heathrow Gymnastics club while their children trained. Indeed it is the talented gymnasts of Heathrow which were some of the first images to be taken by the photographers, and as demand for images grew and the bug for taking photos took hold a photography partnership was forged. Once you have mastered capturing a gymnast at full speed and in full flight often in low light, other subjects can seem an easier option.

Ep Chagger is one of the founding members of ViBe, and a official British Gymnastics Event Photographer, who is well known for his stunning sports aerobics photos, Ep also covers regional, national and international gymnastic events and has supplied many images for the BG 'Gymnast' magazine. He also has covered weddings and takes portraits and other photographic assignments.

John Lumb is the co founder of ViBe, a former police officer medically retired out of the Met police in 2000 through an injury on duty, is also a British Gymnastics Official Events Photographer, covering regional, national and international events, his eye for an image is assisted by the fact that he is a Trampolining Coach. He also covers the Kingston College Sports Academies which include Chelsea F.C Ladies and Staines Town F.C academies and also has a keen eye for landscape photography. He has also

done portrait, wedding, commercial assignments and film premiers.

Adrian Gowans is the IT brains behind ViBe Photography and is solely responsible for getting the website up and running, enabling ViBe to get their images out to the public in a more efficient way. Adrian is also a keen photographer, taking many gymnastic images as well as diversifying into other areas of photography.

The aim of ViBe is to provide exciting and innovative photos at a realistic price and quality image, after all parents spend enough on training fees, kit, travel and other related expenses.

Vibes is the official photographers to the 11 times British Team Champions and highly successful Olympic accredited Heathrow Gymnastics Club, and have recently supplied British Gymnastics with their portrait images of the Olympic qualifying women's artistic team of 2007.

ViBe covers all of the LGF WAG held at Heathrow and recently agreed terms with the LGF Trampolining, DMT and Synchro to cover all events in the LGF calendar. This has also been forwarded to the LGF for consideration for all disciplines covered by the LGF and seconded by LGF Committee members.

ViBe offers clubs and associa-

tions, such as the LGF their services free of charge with the chance to earn a % of the overall takings on the day or in three months time when online sales will be taken into consideration.

ViBe also photograph all the action but employ a strict editing code based on the BG principles and also ensure that the athlete and club is also portrayed in the best way possible so as to not compromise themselves or the sport. These images at present are not currently available due to time constraints as well as editing issues (i.e. poor lighting) this is being looked into at present. All these images are normally online within 24-48hrs of the event for purchase at an extremely competitive rate again. Orders are currently turned around within 48 hrs from point of order and delivery although we state 7 working days to take into consideration postage etc.
